Larry enjoyed traveling to the Oregon Coast and stopping off at Spirit Mountain Casino. He always helped those in need of assistance and enjoyed volunteering with the missionary program at Rock Point Church where he was a member. On Wednesday, May 16, 2012, Larry LeRoy Erickson died at his residence when he was seventy-seven years, six months and three days of age.
