Sally grew up and went to school in a rural area northeast of Linton, North Dakota. She married John Gefreh January 3, 1946 in North Dakota. She farmed with her husband, and was a member of St. Michaels Church there. They moved to Bismarck, North Dakota in 1957 and farmed until 1977. They came to Oregon July of this year. Sally enjoyed keeping her home, baking, caring for her family, crocheting, and dancing. She worked with Catholic Daughters and helped with meals on wheels. On Thursday, September 16, 2010, Sally Gefreh died when she was eighty-five years, one month and three days of age.
