Amelia Ryan Green, age 11, of Sherwood, Oregon, was killed in a car-pedestrian accident on February 20, 2022. She was born December 15, 2010, in Erie, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Kyle and Maggie (Meeker) Green. She was a fifth-grade student at Ridges Middle School, in Sherwood, Oregon. Prior to that, she had been a student at East Hampton Elementary School in Connecticut and at Fairview Elementary School in Fairview, Pennsylvania.

Amelia found the most joy in life doing the simple things: eating her grandma's mac & cheese, camping with her family, playing video games, sketching designs and spending quality time with her brothers.

Amelia's legacy is that of love; she loved everyone without condition. She loved school and was an excellent student. She always had a smile on her face that could light up a room.
