January 28, 1974 - April 5, 2023

Our beloved Amy, wife, daughter, sister, aunt and friend, passed away peacefully on April 5, 2023 in Portland Oregon. She was 49 years old. She died of a traumatic brain injury caused by a motorcycle crash that killed her husband, Raymond Taylor, on March 19, 2023. They were residents of Sherwood, OR.

Amy was born in San Diego, raised in Fullerton, CA, and graduated from Troy High School in 1992. She received a BS in Marine Biology and Zoology from Humboldt State College in 1997. Amy achieved her early ambition as a wildlife biologist for the US Forest Service shortly after that. Her most recent position was in accounts payable for R.A. Gray Construction Company of Tualatin, OR.

Amy is survived by her mother, Marian L. Gibson of Fullerton CA, her sister Diane J. Gibson and her niece Lyra V. Ransom, both of Oceanside, CA. Numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and scores of friends are heartbroken by her death. Her rescue dog, Tootsie, is still waiting at the door for Amy to come home.

In addition to her husband Ray, Amy is predeceased by her stepdad, Dennis J. Gibson.

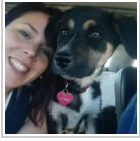
