OBITUARY INFORMATION: Ardath Magee Ardath Magee was born the daughter of Guy and Buna (Davis) Remme on Wednesday, June 21, 1923 in Luverne, Minnesota. Ardath grew up in Dayton, Oregon and graduated from Dayton High School. She married Robert Allen Magee in New York City on August 10, 1944. They lived on the East Coast for a time then moved to Corvallis while Robert was in college. They moved to Dayton in 1953 and then Unionvale where they operated a farm. In addition to being a homemaker, Ardath helped on the farm, driving the truck, packing Easter Lilies, and working with the gooseberry harvest. Robert died in 1991. Ardath moved to Friendsview Manor in 2005. Ardath enjoyed watching sports and inviting people to her home and entertaining. She was a member of the Unionvale Evangelical Church and was the treasurer for many years. On Monday, March 22, 2010, Ardath Magee died at Friendsview Manor when she was eighty-six years, nine months and one day of age. Surviving and left to honor her life are: three sons, Steven Magee of Nampa, Idaho, Bruce Magee of Salem, and Timothy Magee of Salem; her sister Jean Fisher of Walnut Creek, California; four grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren, and those who have come to know and appreciate her where she has lived and worked.
