August 25, 1923 - December 12, 2010

Berthamay "Bertie" Stanley Roberts, 87, died on Sunday, December 12, 2010, at her home in Newberg, OR., of oral Cancer. Bertie was born on August 25, 1923, in Searsboro, Iowa. At age 7, she gave her life to Christ. From 1946-1948, she worked for Youth for Christ in Kansas City, Mo. In Indianola, Iowa, on August 29, 1948, she married Wayne Roberts, and they moved to St. Louis, Mo., for medical school. In 1952, he joined the practice of Dr. Alvin Roberts, in Central Point, OR., Bertie supported him and their five children in every endeavor. At Medford Friends Church, she was a beloved singer, Bible teacher, and promoter of George Fox University in Newberg, OR. In 1991, the Robertses retired to Newberg.
