



Betty Ann Marie St. Pierre

October 24, 1925 - January 31, 2017

Betty Ann St. Pierre passed away peacefully in the afternoon of January 31, 2017 at 91 with family surrounding her.

Betty Ann was born on October 24, 1925 to William Alonzo Clapshaw and Anna Marie Van Loo Clapshaw in Forest Grove, Oregon. The family later moved to Hillsboro where Betty Ann attended St. Matthews Catholic school and Hillsboro High School where she graduated in 1944. Betty Ann was the eldest daughter with two sisters, Virginia and Laura. In July, 1944, Betty Ann was crowned the "Goddess of Liberty" for the Hillsboro Fourth of July celebration.

Betty Ann worked at Bird's Eye in Portland where she was introduced to Kenneth St. Pierre by his uncle. Ken had just returned from World War II serving as a B-17 pilot. Ken and Betty Ann were married at St. Matthews Catholic church on July 6, 1946 and made their home in Southeast Portland. Betty Ann then worked at John Deere and Company as the executive secretary to the general manager of the branch from 1954 to 1984 when she retired. Betty Ann kept in touch with her friends at Bird's Eye and John Deere over all the years. Betty Ann also was a member of a bunco club, the members were together for over 45 years and very close friends. Betty Ann enjoyed sewing, needle work, traveling and most of all her family.

Betty Ann is survived by brother-in-law, Allan Davis, nieces and spouses, Margaret and Glenn, Marilyn and Perry, Nancy and John, Paula and Penny; nephews and spouses/significant others, David and Tina, John and Terri,

Richard, Steven; several grand-nieces and nephews and several great grand-nieces and nephews all of whom loved their Aunt Betty very much.

Betty is predeceased by Kenneth, her parents, her sisters, Virginia and Laura.

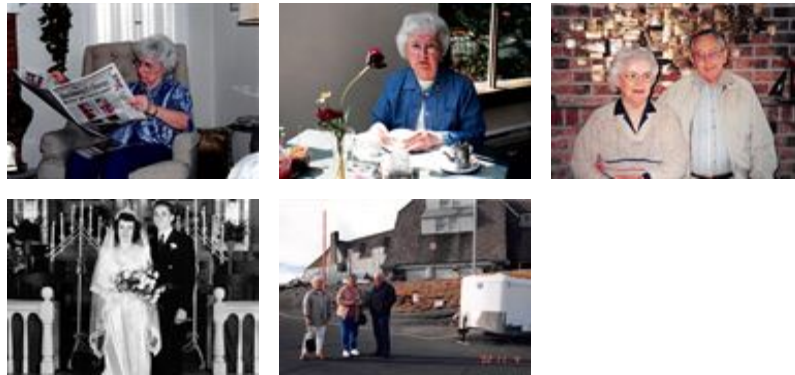
