Carolyn's family moved to Stibnite, Idaho in 1950 where she attended first and second grade. In 1952 the family moved briefly to Salmon, Idaho and then to Boise. She attended several grade schools and junior high school in Boise. She graduated from Greenleaf Friends Academy in 1962 and went to work as a secretary for Mountain States Telephone & Telegraph. In 1963 Carolyn married Roger Wyatt and they made their home in Boise where their first child, Christopher, was born in 1965. In 1966 they moved to Newberg, Oregon, where their second child, Melissa, was born in 1970. Carolyn went to work as a secretary in the Trust Department of 1st National Bank of Oregon, which later became First Interstate Bank and then Wells Fargo. Carolyn retired as an Assistant Vice President and Trust Officer in 1996. In 2000 she went to work for Springbrook Northwest which became Hazelden Springbrook and retired again in 2010. Carolyn was an avid reader and enjoyed working the daily crossword puzzles in the newspaper. She enjoyed jigsaw puzzles, "antiquing" with a friend and spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren. As a member of Newberg Friends Church, she served on the Stewardship committee for a number of years. She also enjoyed singing in the adult choir for over thirty years. On Tuesday, May 10, 2011, Carolyn died at her residence when she was sixty-seven years, zero months and four days of age. Surviving and left to honor her life are: Her father, Carroll Moon of
