Charlotte T. Bischof passed away in her home in Carlton, Oregon November 22, surrounded by her husband and family. She was 83 years old.

She was born to Clinton (Jack) and Helen Harris in Portland, Oregon on October 20, 1939. She married Dennis Bischof on March 28, 1970, in Portland, Oregon and together they raised 3 children. She worked at Waverly Children's home in Portland, Oregon for 11 years. Throughout her life she was a nanny for many children. They resided in Sherwood, Oregon for nearly 50 years.

Charlotte and Dennis founded a non-profit "Stop Hunger and Poverty Now" in 1988. They helped many unfortunate people in their community by distributing food and clothing. Although Charlotte had many medical issues, she did not complain. She always had more concern for others.

Charlotte is survived by her husband, Dennis, her two brothers Gerald (Ruth) Harris of Redmond, Oregon, Gilbert (Marlys) Harris of Sweet Home, Oregon, three children Tanya Bischof of McMinnville, Oregon, Timothy (Christine) Bischof of Newberg, Oregon, Thomas (Tina) Bischof of Carlton, Oregon, eleven grandchildren (including spouses) and six great-grandchildren.

Her family and friends always enjoyed her big hugs and genuine love for them. Charlotte enjoyed reading and music. She spent her life sharing the love of Jesus with others and was very active in the Christian church her whole life.

Charlotte's granddaughter, Ashley Meuret was her caregiver for over a year.

Ashley and her husband, Chris, worked tirelessly to ensure Charlotte was comfortable. They treated her like a queen. After Charlotte's last hospitalization, Serenity Hospice team assisted Ashley in loving care. Charlotte will truly be missed by her family and friends, but Jesus and those in Heaven are happy to see her.
