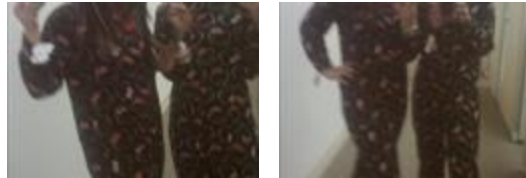

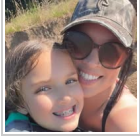

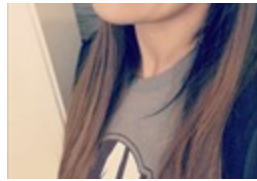

You took a piece of my heart by the way, so I'll need it back when I see you again.

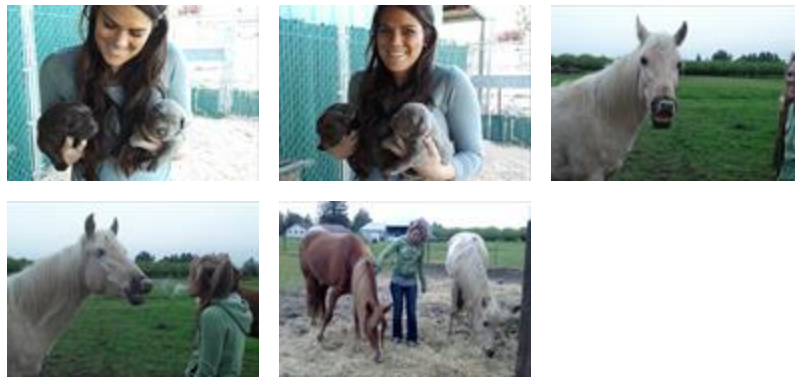

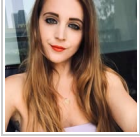

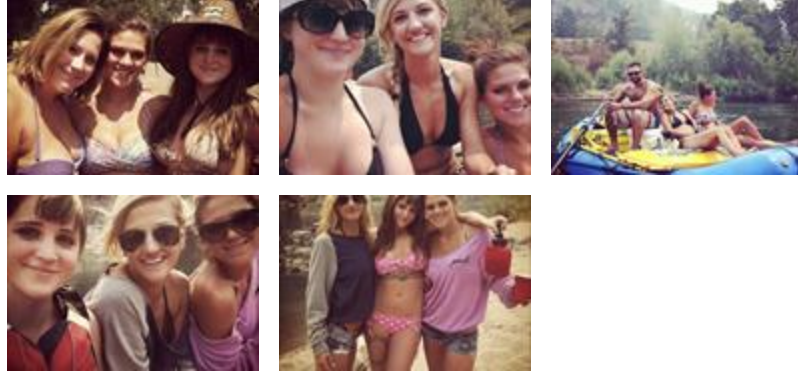
