



DeLaine Joyce Huckey

January 11, 1940 - April 30, 2023

DeLaine “Joyce” Huckey passed away peacefully on Sunday, April 30th at the age of 83. She was born on January 11, 1940 in Streeter, North Dakota to Edward and Bertha Remmick. She was the youngest of 5 children. When Joyce was a year old, her family relocated to St. Johns in Portland where she attended Roosevelt High School. It was there that Joyce met her husband, Larry. He proposed a few weeks shy of her 16th birthday and they were married on August 30, 1958.

In 1968, Joyce and Larry moved to Canyon Creek in Wilsonville where they raised their two children: Lori and Mike. She was an active participant in both the Boones Ferry Days parade and the neighborhood 4th of July parade. She was always up for a good time and was notorious for hosting and planning neighborhood parties. In the late 80’s she started and ran the Wilsonville pet shop “Furs, Fins, and Feathers” with her friend Toni McClesky.

Joyce was the life of the party and she made friends everywhere she went. As she got older she still kept her fun-loving spirit and penchant for getting into “good” trouble. She will be remembered for her dancing, singing, and the twinkle of trouble always in her eye.

Joyce is survived by her daughter Lori Avgerakis (Tom), son Mike Huckey (Margaret), her sister Delphine and her grandchildren Andy, Alex, Kate,

Jimmy, and Ariana and 4 great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband Larry, brothers Delton and Doug, and her sister DeElda.
