



## Donald W. Fouche

September 27, 1949 - December 1, 2019

Donald Wayne Fouche' passed away in his home on December 1, 2019 in Newberg, Oregon. He was 70 years old.

Donald Fouche' was born September 27th, 1949 in Oakland California to his parents, Vernon and Virginia Fouche'.
