She was a huge Oregon State University Beavers baseball fan and collected all kinds of baseball memorabilia, including a beanbag baseball. She also loved bowling and watching golf on television. She was an avid bird watcher, enjoyed going to the Oregon Coast and walking on the beach. Donna especially enjoyed watching the waves through her motel room window when there was a storm. She liked playing the Oregon Lottery, including Keno and video poker and had won several times, playing the same numbers every time. She spent time in Reno and Las Vegas playing the quarter machines. Donna enjoyed playing solitaire and jackpot games on the computer. She was on Facebook and loved keeping in touch with friends and family, and enjoyed spending time with her friends. For many years they would meet once a month to have lunch at different restaurants from McMinnville to Tigard, talking and catching up on old times. She loved and cherished all her friends. Donna also loved animals. She had two pets: a Pomeranian named Bear; and a cat named Max. She was a loving and dedicated mother and

grandmother, going to her grandson's baseball, soccer, band and choir events. Birthdays and holidays were always a special event for Donna. They often met for pizza at Abby's in Newberg. Her family was her pride and joy. Donna's family loved her and will miss her. They are left with giant holes in their hearts. She was there for them, to support them in anything. Donna loved life and always had a smile on her face, with a great outlook on life. On Monday, January 24, 2011, Donna Lysaker died at her residence when she was seventy-three years, one month and twenty-three days of age.
