Doris Conklin was born the daughter of Earl and Beulah (Brown) Brumbaugh on Wednesday, August 17, 1921 in Edgar, Nebraska. Doris grew up and went to school in Edgar, Nebraska where she was raised by her grandparents. On January 13, 1942, Doris married Cecil Conklin. They were married 62 years. They made their home in Harvard, Nebraska, and Doris worked on the Harvard Air Base during World War II. In 1946, her son Gary was born, and they moved to Newberg. Doris worked for McMinnville Woollen Mills, Buckley Lockers, and Dr. Silvers, retiring from there. Doris loved to work in her garden. A weed would not dare pop up there. She also loved to camp, fish, and spend time at the ocean. Doris always had something ready, such as a pie, cookies, cake, etc., in case company dropped by. On Wednesday, November 3, 2010, Doris Brumbaugh Conklin died at Providence Newberg Medical Center when she was eighty-nine years, two months and seventeen days of age.
