When Edward was six years old in 1939, his family moved to Newberg. He attended local schools. At the age of sixteen, Edward worked five years for his uncle, logging in Idaho, and then returned to Oregon. In 1954, he married Margaret Carrick in Dundee, Oregon. Edward worked in refrigeration, and ran the local delivery of the Journal Newspaper. He began driving truck in 1978 for Silvercrest, and retired in 2004. Edward attended the Catholic Church, and he was a part of the Fernwood Grange. He enjoyed hunting and fishing, motorcycling, and camping. Edward was always willing to help out anyone who asked. On Monday, October 7th, 2013, Edward John Baisch died at his residence in Newberg when he was eighty years, six months and twenty-nine days of age.
