It is with great sadness the family of Florence May Kersey announces her death on Friday, December 29, 2017, in Clackamas, Oregon, at the age of 93. Florence will be forever missed by her husband of 75 years, Robert Kersey.

A resident of North Bend for more than 65 years, Florence filled her life with helping others. A member of the First Christian Church for over six decades, she served as a deaconess, church treasurer, and Sunday school teacher and was active in Christian Women's Fellowship. Recognized for her service by Church Women United with the "Valiant Woman" award in 2014, Florence was also a Bay Area Hospital Auxiliary volunteer for many years.

Florence loved to create lovely things and was admired for her garden filled with dahlias, gladiolas, and rhododendrons and her colorfully decorated cakes, but she is most remembered for her love of music. From her selection as song queen in high school through her years as soloist in the church choir, Florence's beautiful voice was a gift she shared with all.

In addition to her husband, Robert, Florence is survived by four of her children, Ron (Carole), Teri (Dino), Barbara and Michael. She was predeceased by her daughter Janice. Florence is also survived by two granddaughters, Tami Harrington and Kristi Burghart, four grandsons, Daniel, Ron, Joshua and Nathaniel Kersey, and 10 great-grandchildren as well as by four of her 11 brothers and sisters: Margaret Clarkson, Lucille Dunham, Howard Speer and Eugene Speer.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, January 6th at 1 pm at Attrell's Funeral Chapel in Newberg, Oregon, where Florence spent her childhood and where she and Robert first met. A burial service for family only will be held earlier that morning at the Fernwood Pioneer Cemetery, also in Newberg.
