She graduated from Whitworth College with a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing and Science in 1945; shortly thereafter enlisting in the Army serving as a nurse for two years. Later she graduated from Deaconess School of Nursing, following with a Master's Degree from Oregon State University in 1954. Gladys married Marvin C. David on July 28, 1951, raising their family in Portland, Oregon. After the kids left the house, he and Gladys became world travelers often "leading" groups of other travelers. Her hobbies included working jigsaw and crossword puzzles and playing cards. The love for her family and friends will always be remembered for her perfect pies and dedicated letter writing, as she never forgot any holiday or special occasion with loved ones all over the world.

Gladys leaves behind 4 children, Valerie Gottlieb, Jan Klein (Mark), Paul David, and Keith David; 10 grandchildren, and 7 great grandchildren.
