Glen Lional Allen Glen Lional Allen was born the son of Charles and Mary (O'Connor) Allen on Sunday, September 16, 1917 in Chadron, Nebraska. Glen grew up and attended school in Nebraska before moving to Sherwood. On January 23, 1946 Glen enlisted in the US Army during WWII where he served in the Pacific Theatre and was honorably discharged with multiple decorations and medals. He married Betty Johnson in 1946, she passed away in 1994. On November 4, 1995, Glen married Ingeburg (Opitz) Mantik and they lived and made their home together in Sherwood. He worked as a shop foreman in the trucking industry and was also a filbert farmer. Glen's many hobbies included hunting, fishing as well as being an avid rock hound (collector). He was a member of the Tualatin Historical Society and also the Oregon City Rock Club. On Wednesday, September 12, 2012, Glen Lional Allen died at a local hospital when he was ninety four years, eleven months and twenty seven days of age.
