Harry Wilson Ocker, Jr. was born June 13, 1922, in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio and died February 10,

2016, in Newberg, Oregon, after a period of declining health.

Harry grew up in Cuyahoga Falls with his parents and seven siblings. After serving in the U.S.

Army in England, France, and Belgium from 1942-1945, he returned to Cuyahoga Falls, where

he married Marilyn Fae Burky of Uniontown, Ohio. After a short period of time, they moved to

Uniontown, where they built a house in 1954. Harry continued to live in the house until August

of 2014, when he moved to Friendsview Retirement Community in Newberg, Oregon, to be

closer to family.

Harry worked at Summit Grinding and Machine in Mogadore, Ohio, as shop superintendent for

56 years, and retired at age 79. He loved to mow his lawn and work in the garden, help his

neighbors, co-teach children's Sunday school with Marilyn, and have fun with his kids.
