In Memory of Joseph Leroy Fogarty Joseph Leroy Fogarty was born the son of Joseph Michael and Shirley (Suverly) Fogarty on May 20, 1921 in Bismarck, North Dakota. Joseph moved to St. Paul in 1956 and then moved to Newberg a year later. He worked in Sherwood for a short period, after which he went to work for Acme Trading and Supply where he worked for more than twenty-five years, retiring in 1982. After retirement, he continued to work in scrap metal. Joseph loved to travel and visit the casino. He enjoyed visiting his family and sharing stories about Bismarck. Joseph enjoyed playing Santa Claus at a local care home. On Tuesday, December 8, 2009, Joseph Leroy Fogarty died at Providence Newberg Hospital when he was eighty-eight years, six months, and eighteen days of age.
