December 26, 1952 - November 18, 2018

Our beautiful mother, Kathleen Joy Church, age 65, passed into the loving arms of our Lord, Jesus Christ on the morning of Sunday, November 18, 2018, after complications from a stroke. She was surrounded and cared for by all three of her children including her siblings, during the last few days of her life. 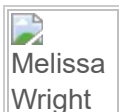
