OBITUARY INFORMATION: Kenneth C. Jaquith Kenneth Carroll Jaquith was born the son of Roy and Elizabeth (Glaser) Jaquith, on Sunday, November 27, 1921 in Hillsboro, Oregon. Kenneth grew up in the Chehalem Mountain area. He attended Mt. Home grade school and graduated from Sherwood High School. Kenneth worked on the family farm. On November 24, 1944 he was married to Gertrude L. Ellis. After they were married he continued working on the farm raising berries and other farm crops. His greatest interest was ministering to others and spreading the love of Christ world wide. He attended the Gospel Chapel, now Rock Point Church for many years. Kenneth's wife of 54 years passed away on March 25, 1999. After her passing he continued to live on the farm. He loved his family and very much enjoyed raising his children. Four of his seven children became pastors. On Saturday, May 14, 2011, Kenneth Carroll Jaquith died at a local hospital when he was eighty-nine years, five months and eighteen days of age.
