Kevin never missed a chance to chat with whoever pulled up in the driveway while he washed his father's car or the travel RV. Instead of saying goodbye he always said "Hasta-la-cha-cha." On Friday, November 11, 2011, Kevin Wayne Selivanow died in the ICU at OHSU after an almost two week battle for his life with his family by his side when he was fifty-two years, eleven months and seven days of age.
