Lloyd W. McFall Longtime Sherwood resident Lloyd W. McFall died January 20, 2013. He was 93. He was born October 19, 1919 in Oshkosh, Nebraska to Roy and Effie (McCabe) McFall. He attended Antioch High School, graduating in 1937. That same year, he moved with his family to Newberg, Oregon, where he met his future bride of 73 years, Irene Dressel. They married in Vancouver, Washington on June 2, 1937. They made their first home in Newberg where their three sons were born. Lloyd served in the United States Army from 1943 to 1946. Following his service to our country, Lloyd began a career in carpentry, building both houses and apartment buildings. In 1955, the family relocated to 17 acres along SW Pacific Hwy in Sherwood, where they raised livestock, cultivated many vegetable gardens and raised their boys. In 1977, Lloyd built Irene a custom home on their property. Lloyd served on both the Sherwood Planning Commission and the City Council. He was instrumental in the development of the Sherwood Senior Center and also served as the President of the Board of Directors numerous times. An avid rock hound, he was a founding member of the Newberg Gem & Mineral Society which was established in 1955. In addition, his hobbies included hunting, woodworking, traveling and displaying at rock shows. Survivors include: wife, Irene, of Sherwood; sons Roger (Mary) of Sherwood, Dennis (Donna) of Portland and Craig, of Beaverton; seven grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers Willard and Darrell; sisters Bonnie, Ruth, Doris and Jean. He will be

remembered as a kind, generous, honest, patient and loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He will be greatly missed. A funeral service was held January 26th at Attrells Funeral Chapel in Newberg. Memorial contributions may be made to the Sherwood Senior Center in Lloyd's name.
