



## Marcella Lulu Halstead

April 13, 1923 - March 24, 2018

Marcella L. (Judes) Halstead was born on April 13, 1923 along with her twin brother, Merle, in Sauk Centre, MN to Carl Henry Judes and Dorothea (Bruns) Judes. They joined a brother, Marvin and a few years later welcomed a brother, Darwin.

They worked hard on their dairy farm. Marcella was proud of her 4-H work. She met Paul Halstead and they dated for seven years before he went off to war in Europe. Marcella moved to Oregon to work in the shipyards. When Paul returned from the war in August 1945, they were married at Grove Lake, MN and then moved to Dundee, OR. They lived in the Dundee-Newberg area their entire married life. Paul and Marcella were married for 46 years before he passed away in March 1991. She was a life-long Lutheran and was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Sherwood for about 72 years. They had seven children. Marcella stayed home to raise their children and when Gail, the youngest, started first grade, she began working at Tektronix in Beaverton where she worked for 25 years. Paul and Marcella enjoyed playing cards, traveling in their small RV to visit family and friends around the United States plus a few trips to Europe. Marcella was also very active in the American Legion Auxiliary.

Marcella died on March 24, 2018 under the loving care of The Springs Memory Care in Sherwood and Hospice. She is survived by her children: Alan
