



## Merlin B Lane

April 1, 1927 - April 29, 2010

In Memory of Merlin B. Lane Merlin Lane was born the son of Wesley and Fern (Winn) Lane on Friday, April 1, 1927 in Osakis, Minnesota. He had four brothers and four sisters. Merlin came to Newberg, Oregon with his parents in 1929. He grew up and attended Newberg schools and graduated from Newberg High School. He joined the Merchant Marines and was in Okinawa on his 18th birthday. Merlin was honorably discharged on August 15, 1945. He married Eunice Hagen and she died in 1988. In 1991 he married Hilda Wilkins. Merlin worked for Ed Kingsley Lumber Company of Portland for 35 years before retirement. He enjoyed woodworking, boating, a little golf, and spending time with his family. Merlin was a member of Northside Community Church. On Thursday, April 29, 2010, Merlin B. Lane died at a Portland Hospital when he was eighty-three years, and twenty-eight days of age. Surviving and left to honor his life his wife, Hilda Lane of Newberg; four children, Teri Zahn of Newberg, Tami (Scott) Phillips of Bend, Kevin (Lori) Lane of Bend, Suzanne (Doug) Gaibler of Oak hill, Virginia; nine grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and those who have come to know and appreciate him where he has lived and worked.
