Mildred R. Mabry Mildred R. Mabry was born the daughter of George and Famie (Burns) Maynard, on Saturday, July 24, 1909 in Dayton, Oregon. Mildred resided in Livingston, Montana from 1913 until 1919 when her family made their move to Chehalem Mountain just north of Newberg. She attended grade school at Pleasant View and later graduated from Newberg High School in 1930. In August of 1930 Mildred married Glenn Miller. They raised their three children Glenice, Eva and Lee on Chehalem Mountain. After a divorce in 1955 Mildred moved to Cornelius. Mildred was a cook in the kitchen at Tuality Community Hospital from 1958 until 1969. On December 24, 1969 she was married to Denver Mabry where they made their home in Cornelius. Fishing was something she liked to do in her spare time. Mildred was very devoted to her family and enjoyed spending precious time with them. On Monday, January 2, 2012 Mildred R. Mabry died at a local care facility when she was one hundred two years, five months and nine days of age.
