In Loving Memory of Nola Olene Hindman Nola Olene Hindman was born the daughter of Thomas Jefferson and Grace Hunter on Tuesday, February 28, 1919 in Elk City, Oklahoma. Nola was raised and attended the local school in Elk City, Oklahoma. She married Floyd in Elk City, Oklahoma April 1935. They moved to Brushy Mountain, Oklahoma and lived there four years, then to Bakersfield, and Fresno, California until 1952. At that time they moved to Newberg and have lived here since. Nola enjoyed sewing, flower gardening, was a member of the Dundee Women's Club, and very dedicated to the family. On Tuesday, July 13, 2010, Nola Olene Hindman, died at a local rehab center when she was ninety-one years, four months and sixteen days of age.
