Norm raised grain and kept livestock while working in Portland at the same time. He also farmed part-time in St. Paul. During his pastime, two things Norm really enjoyed was his farming and fishing. On Saturday, October 6, 2012, Norman Chapman died at a local care facility when he was eighty six years, eight months and sixteen days of age.
