Nov, (Yeay) was a Cambodian Refugee that survived the Khemr Rouge. She had a loving husband Veth Ros and ten kids. Seven of her kids passed during the war and names are unknown. She is survived by her three kids now; Chan Yang, Sharisa Poll, and Vannie Cortez.

Yeay came to the United States in 1986 with her two daughters Sharisa and Vannie, along with her niece Theak Chea. They then resided in Salem, Oregon. Yeay has nine beloved grandchildren; four in Cambodia, and Dan, Derek, Brandon, Sam, and Tati, as well as a great niece; Safina and a great-granddaughter; Amelia.

Yeay was the most humble and thoughtful person. She will always be remembered for how much love and care she put out into the world. She was cared for by her amazing caretaker and son-in-law Louie Cortez

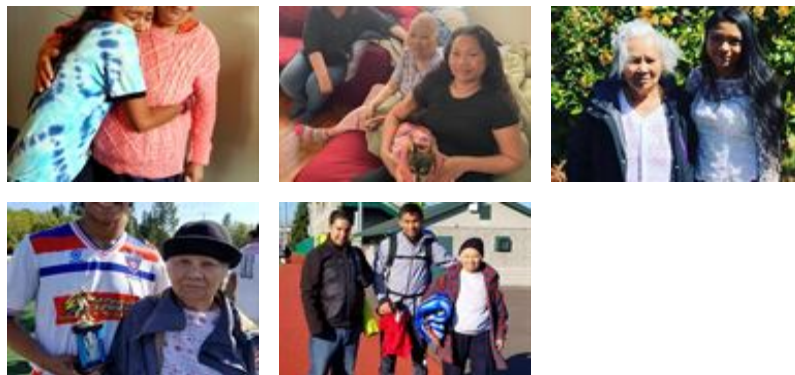
