May 7, 1935 - January 26, 2023

On Thursday, January 26, 2023, Owen Paul Miller passed away while doing his favorite activity—playing pool. He was 87. Born to Orrin and Amy Miller, he graduated from Tooele High School in 1953 and promptly joined the Army. While enlisted, he met the love of his life, Jo Ann (Jodi) from Burien, Washington, and they married in 1958 at the Army Base in Honolulu, Hawaii. They were together for 36 years until her untimely death in 1995.
