He graduated from Nyssa High School. He was married to Mary Jones. Paul attended Prairie Bible Institute in Alberta, Canada in the early 1960's, and was a pastor for seven years. He graduated from George Fox University in 1978 with a Bachelor of Science in Psychology. On August 28, 1980, he married Virginia Clark and they made their home in Newberg. He worked for Bill Page Construction until he started his own construction business in 1982, operating until 2001 when he retired. Paul enjoyed his children and grandchildren, loved the outdoors and was an avid fisherman. He enjoyed reading and was a history buff. Paul was devoted to his wife Virginia. On Tuesday, January 15, 2013, Paul died at a local care facility in Newberg when he was 73 years, 2 months and 24 days of age.
