Rachel Addie Kennedy Rachel Addie Kennedy was born the daughter of Guy and Blanche (Wigent) Summers, on Sunday, June 19, 1927 in Chadron, Nebraska. Rachel grew up in Ainsworth, Nebraska where she attended the local schools, graduating from Ainsworth High School in 1945. On February 11, 1946 she married Paul Kennedy. Together they moved around Nebraska and Colorado for several different farming jobs. They spent two years in South Dakota, from 1948 to 1950 and then returned to Nebraska. In 1955 they moved to Oregon, and have lived in Newberg ever since. Rachel had several local jobs, her longest at Tektronix. After working there for twenty-one years, she retired in 1987. She enjoyed crafts, painting, knitting, ceramics, and horseback riding. Rachel attended First United Methodist Church in Newberg, and was a devoted mother and grandmother. On Saturday, December 24, 2011, Rachel Addie Kennedy died at her residence when she was eighty-four years, six months and five days of age.
