OBITUARY INFORMATION: STANLEY ERNEST GARWOOD Stanley Ernest Garwood was born the son of William and Nellie (Whitlock) Garwood on Saturday, July 24, 1937 in Stevenson, Washington. Stan grew up in Stevenson, where he attended elementary and high school. After graduating high school in 1957, he went to work for the Boeing Company in Seattle, Washington. In 1959, he joined the U.S. Navy, served until 1963, and received an honorable discharge. After the Navy, he worked a variety of jobs until 1969, when he went to work for Milo Schneider Equipment. In that same year, he married Carolyn Waide. In 1973, he went to work for the City of Newberg, where he worked until his retirement in 1998. After he retired, Stan spent a lot of his time traveling the United States with his wife and good friends. In addition to road trips, Stan enjoyed fishing, working on multiple projects around his home and spending time with his family and friends. On Sunday, August 2, 2009, Stanley Ernest Garwood died at his home when he was seventy-two years and nine days of age. Surviving and left to honor his life are: his wife Carolyn; two daughters, Kim Willaman of Albany and Debra Heidrich of Newberg; two brothers, Al Garwood of Wenatchee, Washington and Jim Garwood of Salem; three grandchildren, and those who have come to know and appreciate him where he has lived and worked.
