Also, he was a big outdoorsman, and would go bow hunting, and enjoyed many fishing trips. As an animal lover he had cats his entire life and in later years enjoyed feeding blue birds in their backyard. In addition, he loved to bake bread, pies, and his “famous” holiday rolls.

Steve and Judy lived in Milwaukie for their first years of marriage, then Lake Oswego for 31 years. In their retirement years, they decided to realize their dream of moving to Dundee to enjoy more land, and have a large garden and chickens.
