T. Clio Brown T. Clio Brown, known as Ted, was born the son of Thomas Clio and Laura (Puckett) Brown on Friday, February 3, 1928, in Walnut Creek, Kansas. As an infant, Ted, also known as “TC”, moved with his parents and five older siblings to the Springbrook area near Newberg in a newly converted 1928 RV, built on a new Chevrolet truck. As a young adult, he lived briefly in Kansas, Idaho, and Colorado before returning to Oregon in 1947. He graduated from Salem Academy. TC spent his early working career in the wood products industry. In later years Ted developed a sound reputation breeding Simmental cattle in the Clackamas, Oregon area. Newberg became his home following a serious stroke in 2007. On Friday, May 6, 2011, Ted died at a local hospital when he was eighty-three years, three months and three days of age. Surviving and left to honor his life are: His sister Elizabeth Morse of Chapel Hill, North Carolina; other relatives and friends; many loving nieces and nephews; and those who have come to know and appreciate him where he has lived and worked. His Memorial Service will be Saturday, May 14, 2011, at 3:00 pm in Attrell's Newberg Funeral Chapel, a Golden Rule Funeral Home.
