Terry moved from Ossed, Minnesota to Santa Clara and San Jose areas in California in 1957. He graduated from Santa Clara High School. After graduating high school Terry enlisted in the US Navy and was honorably discharged in 1965. On April 27, 1960 he married Patricia Beebe. They moved to Dundee, Oregon in 1973. In 1974 they moved their family to Newberg, Oregon where they have made their home since. Terry was a member of the Steam Fitter and Pipe Fitter Union. He enjoyed taking family trips in his RV. Terry was quite the woodworker and also took joy in Square Dancing. He also held a Private Pilot's license. Terry loved spending time with his family. He was a long time member of Newberg Christian Church.
