Thomas “Tom” H. Eakes, age 87, transitioned peacefully to be with Jesus early Christmas morning on Saturday, December 25, 2021. Tom spent Christmas with the love of his life, Joanie his wife who had previously passed on July 22, 2006.

Tom was born in Port Arthur, Texas on September 5, 1934 to Lila Easter Parks and William Thomas Eakes. He had two older sisters Mary Lou Richards, and Lucy Easter McDaniel affectionately called, “Rusty”.

Tom’s accomplishments include; serving our country in the Air Force, first class in 1952. After his 4-year commitment in the military, Tom graduated Bible Standard College in Eugene on June 4, 1959. On August 13, 1966 he received a Bachelor degree in Theology at NW Christian College. Tom met his wife, Joan Franklin in Bible College. The couple married on February 17, 1962. Together they served as a team in the Ministry for over 40 years. Tom and Joan were married for 44 years. After Joan’s death in 2006, Tom decided to semi-retire from the Ministry.

August 26, 2008, he found employment in the shoe department at Fred Meyer in Newberg, OR. Tom earned numerous Customer Service Awards, where he delighted his guests with stories and songs. He also officiated over several, fellow employee wedding ceremonies. Tom had a heart for children. On several occasions, Tom would secretly purchase shoes when parents could not afford them. He would make sure the shoes were delivered to the child in need. Tom will be remembered affectionately as, “Mr. Thomas” by his fellow work associates, at Fred Meyer. He was still technically employed at age 87. Retirement was not in Tom’s vocabulary, because work was never a four-letter word to him.

Tom is survived by his two daughters, Rhoda Karis (Peter) and Kimberly Johnson (Gilbert); three grandsons, Joshua Johnson, Chase Kairis and Jesse Johnson (Hilary); one great-grandson Parker Kairis; two fur babies, Sunflower and Solo aka ‘Fat Cat’.
