Valorie Jean Andrews was surrounded by loved ones and clung to their hands and hearts as she peacefully went to be with our Lord on August 23, 2017. Val was a wonderful mother, mother-in-law, grandmother and great grandmother. As an only child she married into a large family and was a beloved aunt and great aunt to many. Born in Chatfield, Minnesota, she moved to Newberg with her mom at age 7 in 1935.

Val graduated in 1945 from Newberg High School and in 1946 she married the love of her life Kenney Andrews of Dundee OR, who she survived by almost 30 years. Once Kenney returned from his World War 2 military service with the US Army Air Corp, they soon started their family. Within a few years they moved into their house on E. Second Street where she lived for over 67 years. Val treasured her job as a wife to Kenney and mother to Dave and was then blessed with grandchildren to continue her nurturing way. Val is survived by her son Dave Andrews-Newberg (Maggie) Grandchildren Alicia Dickenson-Newberg (Lawrence); Lindsey Whitman-Spokane WA.
