In Memory of Virgil Kenneth Doades Virgil Kenneth Doades was born the son of Elmer and Minnie (Peach) Doades on Friday, July 26, 1918 in Illinois. Virgil attended the local schools in Indiana graduating high school. He worked for several different companies and he drove trucks in Evansville, Indiana. Virgil married Ruth Kinnett, March 6, 1943 in Washington, Indiana. They moved to Englewood California in 1954, where he worked for Hughes Aircraft as a machinist. He then transferred to Fullerton, California where he retired in 1977. They then moved to Arizona 3 years later, and then moved to Dundee to be closer to his family. Ruth died in 2005. Virgil enjoyed fishing, camping and traveling. He was past member of the Masonic Lodge in Anaheim, California, and Grange #273 in Tillamook, Oregon. On Friday, June 11, 2010, Virgil Kenneth Doades died at a local nursing home when he was ninety-one years, ten months and sixteen days of age.
