Walter Edward Korb was born the son of Leonard and Divah Hazel (Bryant) Korb on Saturday, April 2, 1918 in Pueblo, Colorado. Walter lived in several states before making his home in Oregon. He married Gertrude Allison in Portland on June 23, 1945. He owned Walter Korb Insurance in Sherwood for 46 years and was active in the community. Walter was a longtime Little League coach and coached American Legion baseball for years in Sherwood. Walter started a coffee group of businessmen fifty-four years ago that is still meeting today. He enjoyed travelling, watching baseball, hunting and being with family and friends. On Sunday, September 19, 2010, Walter Edward Korb died at Providence Newberg Hospital when he was ninety-two years, five months and seventeen days of age.
